

FLEXTILE 710 PREMIUM VINYL FLOORING ADHESIVE

BASIC USES

Flextile 710 Premium Vinyl Flooring Adhesive is a pressure sensitive, high-strength, high-tack adhesive for the installation of Stone Plastic Composite (SPC) tile, Luxury Vinyl Tile (LVT), Vinyl Plank and similar floorcoverings over approved porous and non-porous substrates.

COMPOSITION AND MATERIALS

A medium-bodied latex resin emulsion which develops a bond of exceptionally high strength when used as per instructions.

FEATURES

- · Extended open time, fast dry time, and ease of application.
- Outstanding water resistance and tenacious bond strength for demanding installations such as hospitals, schools, nursing homes, and hospitality.
- Excellent shrinkage resistance and plasticizer migration resistance ideal for use with all solid vinyl flooring.
- Formulated with an anti-microbial system to protect the adhesive from bacterial and fungal growth.
- Higher moisture resistance, suitable over fresh concrete slabs with moisture vapor emission rates up to 3,63 kg per 92,9 m² (8 lbs. per 1,000 sq. ft.) per 24 hours.
- · Environmentally friendly, VOC-free formula: ideal for densely occupied buildings.

LIMITATIONS

- · Not for outdoor use. Not for below grade installations.
- Shelf life: 2 years from date of manufacture, in unopened container.
- Storage: Indoors at a temperature between 18°- 30°C (65-85°F).
- · Do not allow product to freeze.
- Cannot be used over substrates that have been chemically cleaned. A bond test MUST be performed.

SUBSTRATES

Sound and properly prepared concrete (on grade and above) and CSA/APA approved wood subflooring. Substrates must be clean and dry, free of dust, dirt, paint, wax, existing adhesives, or other contaminants including curing compounds that may interfere with the adhesive bond. Do not use on chemically cleaned substrates. Asphalt-based or cutback adhesive stains must be removed completely.

SUBSTRATE CONDITIONS:

Flextile 710 Premium Vinyl Flooring Adhesive may be used for installations over on or above grade concrete substrates with up to 95% in-situ Relative Humidity per latest version of ASTM F2170 and pH between 8.0 – 11.0. HVAC must be in operation and interior ambient air temperature and Relative Humidity must be maintained between 18 °C- 30 °C (65 °F- 85°F) and 40-65% RH for at least 48 hours prior to, during and continuously after the testing, preparation and final installation. The substrate temperature should be at least 5 °F higher than the Dew Point.

ASTM F2659 impedance moisture meter testing is required due to issues related to topical moisture from dew point.

Concrete substrate surface should not read over 4% on the impedance meter for this adhesive application.

INSTALLATION

PREPARATORY WORK

Surfaces must be sound, even, dry and free of grease, oil, dirt, paint, curing compounds or sealers, or other foreign matter.

APPLICATION

Refer to installation instructions of the flooring manufacturer. Pour a small quantity of adhesive on the floor and, with a firm hand, spread evenly using a trowel having 1.6 mm (1/16") V-notches on 1.6 mm (1/16") centers. AS SOON AS ADHESIVE HAS CURED TO A TACKY FILM, APPLY FLOOR COVERING. Roll floor immediately after each section has been installed with a 35 – 25 kg (75-100 lb) 3-section roller.

CURING and TRAFFIC

Restrict foot traffic for 24 hours after installation, and heavy traffic, rolling loads or furniture placement for 72 hours after installation. Additional time may be necessary if the installation is over a non-porous substrate. Allow at least five days following the installation before conducting wet cleaning procedures or initial maintenance.

CLEAN UP

Use a clean wet cloth to clean up adhesive while still wet. Dried adhesive may require the use of an appropriate solvent.

SAFETY
